WARREN HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING
Monday, April 16th, 2007

Secretary's report from February was read and approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew was not present. President Rich Jugler reported that the boosters made over \$4000 at the basket bingo and that we were overbilled \$1700 from the school board for busses and other miscellaneous fees.

The basket bingo this year proved profitable as it was the largest turnout we have had with 140 people. The success was attributed to the advertising effort that was made by Mr. Jugler and Mr. Powell. We need to make sure that next year we get the signs out early and advertise in the papers again.

Mrs. Powell is still interested in becoming the President in May. Mr. Powell said he would be happy to co-chair the Concession stands and he would be in charge of supplies if someone else would manage the workers. Mrs. Joyce is now the chair of the calendar sales.

Alan Kern took the small trailer to have the logo added to it.

Mrs. Joyce presented the calendar sale to the boosters. She will have our calendar representative join us at the May meeting to discuss in more detail. Mrs. Joyce mentioned that in the past the band has made the most money off of the birthdays and dates to remember in the calendars. She mentioned we might want to consider doing both the large wall calendars and the pocket calendars to try and make more money. She asked for 2-3 helpers to contact advertisers. Mrs. Joyce also mentioned that we need to take orders at the end of August and have them turned in by early October to have them in time for January. All proceeds from this fundraiser will go to the bus fees

Mrs. Foster presented the 2007 guard uniform to the boosters and asked the boosters to allow up to \$3000 for the cost of 26 guard uniforms. Motion was made to approve by Marcie Arnold and second by Alan Kern, motion was passed.

Mrs. Deem presented the senior favors, which were a glass with the band logo and all the senior names. Motion was made to approve up to \$500 for the senior favors, motion was second and approved.

There were no bills presented at the time.
