

Warren Local Band Booster Minutes
WARREN HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING
Monday, February 11, 2008

Secretary's report from January was read and approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew was not present at the time, but Mrs. Powell reported that the band has \$23,701.94 in the General Checking Account and \$42,198.58 in the Securities Account and at Note Payable for the new truck of -\$25,990.00, for a total fund of \$39,910.52.

Mrs. Powell said that we have received the bus bill, but we are waiting for the invoice to be broken down into more details. She also reported that the Securities Account is still in process. The boosters also decided to table the Hat & Shirt Shop bill until the next booster meeting.

The band's Basket Bingo will be held on Saturday, April 5th, 2008. Mrs. Powell met with Susie Ashley and ordered 23 baskets for a total of \$1,488.60. Mrs. Ashley was kind enough to refund us her commission, so the total cost of the baskets was \$1,231.10. Mr. Foster mailed out the letters to the sponsors this week. We still need someone to contact WTAP and the Marietta Times. Mrs. Foster will make signs and bring them to the next meeting. Mr. Foster will laminate them and have the students staple them to the political signs. Mrs. Hamilton and Mrs. Walker will co-chair the concessions and baked goods. Mr. and Mrs. George will work on the attendee packets. Mr. Foster will again do the calling for bingo and Mr. Kern will get the bingo machine for us.

The Car Show will be held at Ken's Car Care on May 24th from 4-8pm. There was talk that the boosters will ask parents to donate items, but we need a parent to coordinate getting the donations. We also need someone to coordinate the concessions.

Mr. Foster reported that the Indoor Percussion Ensemble did a fantastic job at their first competition. Their next one is scheduled for March 29th in Westerville.

Mrs. Powell reported that we are still in need of the following officers – Vice President and Treasurer – both are 2 year terms; Secretary – 1 year term.

The band banquet is on May 16th. Senior parents need to start planning the senior favors and decorations for the hall. The junior parents will organize the kitchen.

Mr. and Mrs. Foster presented a possible new fundraising event for the boosters. The company is called Artistic Impressions and they would create yard signs for band, football, cheerleaders, basketball, etc and the band boosters can sell them to the entire student base. The cost per sign is \$9.75 and we can sell them for \$20.00. It does cost \$20.00 to make up each imprint for each sporting event. Mrs. Powell will follow-up on this.

Mrs. Foster mentioned that she will be sending out recruitment forms to the 8th graders, and she needs to know what the band fees for next year will be. It was decided that the executive committee will discuss this at their budget meeting and decide on the appropriate band fee.
