WARREN HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING
Monday, January 14, 2008

Secretary's report from November was read and approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew was not present at the time, so there is no treasurer's report.

Mr. George will plan on picking up the trailer later this week and take it over to Irvine's to have it measured for the awning which is being donated by Irvine's Campers.

Mrs. Hayes reported that the Rada fundraiser brought in about \$2,400 and the That's My Pan profited \$1,700.

The Basket Bingo will be held on April 5th, from 12-4, doors will open at 12pm and bingo will start at 1pm. We need a band parent to call Susie Ashley and look into getting the Longaberger baskets ordered in January since we will get the best deals. Mr. Foster volunteered to send the initial letter to the sponsors, asking them to donate, preferably \$50 to \$100 – but they can also donate items to fill the baskets as well. We need a chairperson for publicity – the band students will create the signs, but we need a parent to contact the paper and WTAP, etc. We also need a band parent to fill the attendee packets with the menu, and games and help sheet. Mrs. Hamilton and Mrs. Walker are co-chairing the concessions and baked goods. Mr. Foster already has the cafeteria reserved for the event. Mr. Kern will get the bingo machine from the K of C again this year.

Mrs. Powell reported that she emailed all the band parents regarding the Car Show on May 24th and had a very good response. We do need 100 donations and a band parent to collect and make sure we have 100. Mr. Foster will contact Betty at Ken's to see exactly what kind of donations they want. We also need a band parent to chair the concessions.

Mr. Foster reported on the Indoor Percussion Show, he said it is going very well and the kids are very excited about it. He contacted a local sign company and got a 20' by 50' tarp donated to us to use for the show. The students will be painting it this Friday.

Mr. Foster also mentioned that he decided on the 2008 Marching Band Show and it is called "Heartbeat" by Key Poulan. The entire show will cost \$2000. A motion was made by Mr. Barth to approve and was seconded by Mrs. Hamilton, motion was approved.

Mr. Foster also mentioned that we need a few chaperones for the Solo & Ensemble contest on January 26th. This is the largest group we are taking to the event.

Mrs. Powell reported that offices of the Vice President and Treasurer are open this year and Mrs. Foster will also be stepping down as Secretary since she took on an extra term and we need a band parent to fill her position for 1 year.
