Secretary's report from February was read and approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew was not present at the time, but Mrs. Powell reported that the band has \$20,013.71 in the General Checking Account; \$17,737.89 in the Bingo Account; \$8,664.40 in the Truck Savings Account; CDs in the amount of \$15,796.29; and a note payable for the band truck for \$25,990, for a total fund of \$36,210.25.

Mr. George said we are still looking into getting the awning for the trailer. He needs to take the trailer over to Irvine's Campers to see if they have one that fits.

Mrs. Powell reported on the Basket Bingo. We have purchased all the baskets. Mrs. Roberts has been doing a fantastic job on going to businesses in Little Hocking and Belpre for donations, we will need someone to go to businesses in Marietta. Mrs. Treadway emailed the Marietta Times and WTAP for publicity. Mrs. Foster created signs and brought them to the meeting so parents can take them and post them around town. Mr. & Mrs. George are working on the attendee packets. Mrs. Powell has posted sign up sheets for workers in the band room.

There was discussion about the Car Show which is on May 24th. We need someone to coordinate the donations from the band families. Each band family needs to donate 2 items. Mrs. McDowell will call the parents for donations. We still need a coordinator for the concessions. Mrs. Powell has placed signup sheets for workers in the band room.

The band banquet is right around the corner on May 16th. Senior parents, Mrs. McGrew and Mrs. Hayes will work on the senior gifts and decorations. Mrs. Roberts and Mrs. Hamilton will coordinate the kitchen.

We are still in need of a Vice President and a Treasurer – both 2 year terms, and a Secretary which is a 1 year term.

The executive committee met last week and decided on a budget for next year of \$57,400. Motion was made to approve, motion was second and approved.
