WARREN HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING
Monday, May 7th, 2007

Secretary's report from April was read and approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew reported that the checking account has \$19,319.57, bingo account has \$17,642.93, truck account has \$8,648.10 and we rolled the \$15,000 in CDs again and they will be up again in September. Total band funds are \$60,599.01.

Mrs. Angie Powell is the candidate for president, a motion was made by Mrs. McGrew to elect Mrs. Powell as president, Mrs. Joyce second the motion, motion was passed.

Mr. Powell is looking for a co-chair for the concession stands, he has received the key from Mrs. Fox.

Mr. Kern was not present, but at the last meeting he was going to pick the small trailer up from the logo shop.

Kathy from Gordon Bernard calendars was present at the meeting to discuss the fundraiser in more detail to the boosters. Mrs. Joyce now has a committee of volunteers and they will present the different options to the boosters at the July meeting. It was decided that the calendars are due to company on October 15th so we would need to have all calendars in at least the week before.

A discussion arose about the bus fees, parents questioned going to away games to help save, it was decided that Mrs. Powell would speak with Mr. Leffingwell to see what we can do about the situation as well as the school board.

Mrs. Powell and Mrs. Arnold will work on the uniform committee again this year, they decided that we did not need as much time as we had allotted last year, they will email Mrs. Foster the schedule they would prefer.

Mrs. Fox reported that we are still waiting on \$1500 from this years concession stands from the Athletic Boosters.

Mrs. Foster asked the boosters to approve up \$1000 for flag fabric for this years show. There are four songs and the 3rd song will be using large double flags. A motion was made to approve the flag budget, motion was second and approved.

Mr. Foster asked the booster to approve the marching band shows copyright fees, motion was made to approve, motion was second and approved.
