

## **WARREN HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS MEETING**

### **Monday, November 12, 2007**

President Mrs. Powell called the meeting to order and the minutes were read from October's meeting. A motion was made to accept the minutes, they were seconded; motion approved.

Treasurer Mrs. McGrew reported that the checking account has \$43,311.20, the bingo account has \$17,714.20, the truck savings account has \$8,658.94 and we still have the 3 CD's with \$15,796.29 for a total fund of \$59,478.90.

Mrs. Powell mentioned we are still waiting to hear about the trailer awning from Irvine's Campers.

Mrs. McGrew reported that the Rada Knives brought in about \$1,500 and there are still a few parents that need to pick up their orders at the Shield's house.

Mrs. McGrew stated that the That's My Pan profited \$1,341 and there are still more orders out. Mrs. Hayes said we can take orders for as long as we like.

Mrs. McGrew also reported on the Craft Fair. It went very well. We brought in \$20,027.50 with expenses at \$3,692.00 for a profit of \$16,335.

Mrs. Kern reported on the tractor raffle. 2280 tickets were sold. \$1824 of the sales goes to kids for fees or BOA spending money. Our expenses were \$1991 and the winner took the tractor. We made a profit of \$5649.

The Foster's reported on the trip to Grand Nationals. Everything is all set up and ready to go. Mrs. McGrew has the money for the bankers. Mrs. Foster will be handing out the chaperones folders with agendas and attendance lists to the chaperones on the 14th.

Mr. Foster stated he would like to start an Indoor Percussion Ensemble that performs at 2 basketball games and competes at 2 competitions in Columbus. There was discussion of having a fee for the percussion members, but a motion was made by Mr. Barth to allow Mr. Foster to do the show and to not incorporate any fees, but the ensemble needs to do fundraisers to offset the cost. Motion was second and approved. Total cost for the indoor show is \$2000.

Basket Bingo is on April 5<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Jugler said we need to buy dobbers. Mrs. Jugler said last year we bought the baskets in January so we need to start looking into those soon.

Mr. Foster reported that December 1<sup>st</sup> is the Barlow Christmas Parade and Mr. Jugler asked if we wanted to create an outdoor light display to show at the Barlow Fair Grounds. After discussion, it was decided that we would wait since this is a BOA year.

A possible fundraiser for the band is a car show. We would need to raise 100 donations and door prizes and it will be held at Ken's Car Care on 339 on May 24<sup>th</sup> from 4-8pm. The concessions would be run by the boosters and would be all our profit. After lengthy discussion with concerns about parental involvement and a rain out, it was decided that Mrs. Powell would email all the band parents and see what their consensus is as Ken's Car Care needs to know ASAP.
